FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

LOCATION

The event will start and finish at “The Lake”, Princess Ave, Llandrindod Wells, Powys, LD1 6BL.

The start area will be fenced and signed.

SIGNING ON

Wednesday 26th June 10am – 5.30pm

- Collect your number from white tent and put number straight on the bike.
- Collect tag from the fuelling team to confirm you have paid for your fuel.
- Take your bike, empty of fuel, down to be filled.
- Take your bike to be inspected on entrance into Parc Ferme, you will need a stand for your bike, a side stand is acceptable.
- Helmets must be presented at time of machine examination and must have a Silver or Gold Standard ACU stamp. You will not be allowed to take part using helmets not bearing this stamp
- Bikes will not be examined without the rider number displayed on the front and side of the bike
- Please exit the Parc Ferme via the white tent, where you sign on, sign and pay deposit for transponder hire, and collect timecard, programs and mugs etc.
- **You MUST have photo ID to sign on**
- **Please make sure you have your driving licence or £20 deposit for the transponder hire.**
- **Any riders under 18 will require either a parent, guardian or responsible adult to countersign their signing on.**

Tyres

Please make sure you have the correct tyres and you know where the mark is on the tyre, to make it faster when being inspected.

Marks that should be showing on your tyres, should be one of the following.

- Tyres must have a E mark on them OR
- Dot mark OR FIM
- Have "Enduro" written on them
- 13mm depth maximum

**** Riders will be allowed into the compound 15 minutes before their start time on Thursday morning where they will collect their bikes and push them to the start line. ****

Competitors must be aware that the security of their machine and other property always remains their responsibility. Competitors are reminded to ensure that their insurance and security arrangements adequately protect their possessions while they are at the event. It is strongly recommended therefore that additional insurance is taken out to cover bike security. The club/ landowner does not accept any liability for the storage or security of any machines or equipment.

TRANSPONDERS

Transponders are more reliable on your wrist (like a watch), they can go on your bikes but need to go on bar pad **facing up**.

!! THESE ARE THE RIDER'S RESPONSIBILITY, IF YOU FORGET YOUR TRANSPONDER ONE DAY, YOU WILL HAVE NO TEST TIME !!

Please bring £20 deposit/ driving licence for deposit for transponder.

ROUTE INFORMATION

Day 1 – **orange** arrows

Day 2 – **green** arrows

There are **4 special tests this year**. Pantglass and Abbeycwmhir are available for walking from 12pm on Tuesday 25th June and then all tests available for walking from 9am on the Wednesday 26th. Locations are in your program and will be on the notice board by the signing on tent. Please follow the **blue service arrows** to tests on the **Wednesday**. Under **NO** circumstances is anybody aloud to walk any of Lea Hall or Werngoch Before dates and times stated above, anyone found doing so could face exclusion! Also There are **NO** mountain bikes/E bikes or any form of wheels to be ridden on the test, again doing this could face exclusion.

Test 1 (Test 4, day 2) – Wrengoch Farm ///dockers.rummage.patrolled

Test 2 (Test 3, day 2) – Lea Hall Farm ///deodorant.rapport.gagging

Test 3 (Test 2, day 2) – Pantglas ///elevated.treetop.denoting

Test 4 (Test 1, day 2) – Abbeycwmhir ///stoppage.standards.levels

Championship riders will ride **ALL** tests back-to-back.

Between checks 5 and 6 straight after Pantglas test there will be an extra 10 minutes for service.

Any servicing of bikes, you must use an environmental mat, please take all rubbish, mud, tyres home with you from around the lakeside and from service points

You **MUST** go all the way around the lake to service and refuel at the end of day 1 ready for day 2, there will be a stamp check around the lake. As above, it is a one way system, and you must include this in your 20 minutes.

Please can all motorbikes and service vehicles adhere to all speed limits around the towns and villages at all times, some of which are 20MPH. Also be aware some lanes are single track so please take time.

SUPPORT VEHICLES

There are a number of very sensitive conservation areas within the event and it is a condition for our club's continued use that we respect this environment. Under no circumstances is out riding permitted with motorcycles or other vehicles. Failure to carry out these instructions will result in their rider being excluded from the event.

Please do NOT park in any gateways that are on the route, this is for visibility reasons

SERVICE ROUTE IS THERE FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE. PLEASE ONLY FOLLOW THE SERVICE ARROWS.

Day 1 – **Blue** arrows

Day 2 - **Red** arrows

Between checks 5 and 6 straight after Pantglas test there will be an extra 10 minutes for service.

There is no fuelling at any time from the support crew, fuelling can only be made by Vital Equipment, who are supplying fuel and oil. If you are seen fuelling outside of designated areas, it will be immediate disqualification.

CAMPING AREA

The lake is a ONE-WAY system.

Please Park to the LEFT around the lake, in between the bollards, there is a lot of us to get in, so please park sensibly, snuggle up!!

Camping will be available around the Lake. There will be camping on the Lakeside Common BUT ONLY From Wednesday morning.

Shower facilities will be available at the local Rugby Club on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 4pm - 9pm, directions are in the program.

RUBBISH

Rubbish skips and bins will be provided within the start/finish area. Please ensure all your rubbish, litter is placed within it or taken home by you. There is CCTV camera in place to ensure there is no fly tipping.

TOILETS

Toilets are provided within the start/finish area. As well as at each test.

REFRESHMENTS

Will be available at the start/finish area from 6am from the Lakeside Café. There will also be catering vans at the special tests.

FIRST AID

First Aid cover for the event will be provided by Mid Wales Medical Service with a paramedic in attendance. First Aid points will be Located in the Start/Finish area and at each special test. In the event of any incident, this should be reported to our Safety Officer/Clerk of the Course. Contact number is on every rider's wristband and marshal wristbands. All head marshals will have radios on them.

Please stay hydrated, it is your responsibility to hydrate. There is no water supplied around the course, please make sure your support crew are fully stocked.

RETIREMENT

If you retire, you must ensure that your time card is handed at the Start/Finish control to enable the club to account for all riders at the conclusion of the event.

OTHER INFORMATION

The event is run under the ACU Enduro SR, Supplementary Regulations for the event and Final Instructions.
